After acknowledging the above, the undersigned hereby released and forever discharges the Humane Society of Westmoreland County, its directors, agents, employees, representatives, attorneys, successors and assigns of and from any and all claims, causes of actions, damages, costs, attorney's fees or demands of whatever nature with regard to any accident, damage, or injury that may result from activities at or on behalf of the Humane Society of Westmoreland County.

I will not touch animals not included in my volunteer duties. I understand infection control. My hands will be washed between animal rooms and kennels.

That during the course of meetings, public interactions, employee and board information exchanges and daily shelter activity that there may be disclosed to me certain confidential information of the HSWC consisting of but not limited to: technical information including methods, processes, systems, techniques, computer programs and projects, and business information including customer lists, pricing data, sources of supply, financial data and marketing and fundraising plans.
